Renewals: The Southern Illinois Continuum of Care is currently accepting HUD CoC renewal grants from projects that submitted a letter of intent in May 10, 2019. The deadline to submit renewal applications with supporting documentation for the ranking and review process is **August 30, 2019**. Project applications must be submitted through esnaps and supporting documentation should be submitted to: Camille Dorris at 1009 W. Cherry St., Marion, IL 62959 by that same date. For information about the amount of funding available for renewal projects, contact Sue Castleman, CoC President or Linda Bookwalter, Collaborative Agent.

New Projects: New projects are also being accepted that meet the local CoC's priorities and fall into the following HUD categories:

- Expansion of a renewal
- Reallocation of funding for renewal projects
- Bonus funding
- Domestic Violence Bonus funding
- Projects may also apply for a combination of reallocation and bonus funding

For information about the amount of funding available for new projects and whether they fall into the CoC's priorities, contact Sue Castleman, CoC President or Linda Bookwalter, Collaborative Agent. Requirements, eligibility, amounts and processes differ among the types of funding, so potential applicants should familiarize themselves thoroughly before applying. The deadline to submit new applications with supporting documentation for the ranking and review process is **August 30, 2019**. Project applications must be submitted through esnaps and supporting documentation should be submitted to: Camille Dorris at 801 N. Market St, Marion, IL 62959.

Ranking and Review Process: All projects (renewal, reallocated, bonus and DV Bonus) who submitted their project applications to the CoC by the established deadline will be reviewed and ranked by the Ranking and Review Committee. Project applicants will be notified of their status which could include their ranking on the CoC Priority Listing; project rejection or reduction by September 12, 2019. Where a project application is being rejected or reduced, the CoC will indicate the

reason(s) for the rejection or reduction in writing 15 days before the CoC deadline of September 30, 2019.

Tiers: Projects will again be placed into funding Tiers. Tier 1 is equal to 100 percent of the combined Annual Renewal Amounts for all projects eligible for renewal for the first time plus 94 percent of the combined Annual Renewal Amounts for all other projects eligible for renewal. Once this amount has been reached, projects will be placed in Tier 2. If a project straddles both tiers, it will be placed into Tier 2.
