

**SICOCN
2019 PROJECT RANKING FORM
ALL PROJECTS**

This form is to be used to place projects in their ranked order. HMIS is required by HUD, and therefore SICOCN ranks it first on the ranking form. HUD funding emphasizes PH-RRH in the NOFA. SICOCN will therefore rank in that order, with PH-RRH projects, including reallocation projects, being ranked in order of points earned, then PH projects ranked in order of their points earned and TH projects ranked in order of their points. Special circumstances of a project may be considered in the ranking order. In the event of projects with the same score within the same ranking category, the projects will be placed in alphabetical order. If the total of all projects exceeds 94% of the Continuum Annual Renewal Demand amount (Tier 1), the final ranked project will be split into both tiers, as directed in the NOFA. New projects will be ranked in order of points after all renewals and in Tier 2 if necessary.
